




A elderly perspective on ICT for e-inclusion: the ELDY experience

The seminar



Organised within the framework of **Marie Curie IAPP project Value ageing**, the seminar represents a stimulating opportunity to share knowledge and deepen analysis about the e-inclusion of the elderly persons in the information society from two perspectives, academia and industry.

The incorporation of European values in ICT for older persons will be discussed in the light of the experience of **ELDY** (<u>www.eldy.eu</u>), an NGO promoting a free software to facilitate access to computers and the Internet by older persons and persons with disabilities.

The panel of speakers will include researchers from the Vrije Universiteit Brussels (VUB), members of the ELDY platform and ELDY's technology partner Vegan Solutions s.r.l, as well as experts from the European Institutions and European old age organisations.

The seminar is occasioned by the launch of a version of **ELDY** in Dutch language, which will be presented and discussed with representatives of the Vlaamse OUDERENRAAD vz.

How to arrive

By plane: Brussels Airport (Zaventem) is the largest airport in Belgium. Most international flights arrive here. From Brussels Airport you can reach the campus by train or by bus (bus 12, Brussels City).


By train: The campus is located next to the railway station "Etterbeek". Consult the timetables of the Belgian National Railroad Company. (NMBS)

By car: A system of electrical bollards is in use at Campus Etterbeek to limit parking and traffic nuisance. The system works on the basis of number plate recognition. People whose number plate is not immediately recognised can register via the intercom.



By subway/tram/bus:

Subways, trams and buses in Brussels are run by the MIVB. Subwaystations "Petillion" and "Delta" are closest to the Campus (+/- 15 minutes walk). There are several trams and buses from the different train stations in Brussels. Please consult the timetables of the MIVB.
